# Football Fans Engagement Group Terms of Reference

#### **Purpose:**

To provide scrutiny, support and transparency to the Cheshire Constabulary's approach to the delivery of football policing operations. This will ensure that operations are balanced and proportionate. This will ensure that the Constabulary is effectively discharging their policing responsibilities in this area. The group can also provide guidance, support and opinion around some of the national themes in this area that are emerging from a public perspective.

#### Membership

The membership will be drawn from across the main football Clubs in the County (Crewe FC/ Macclesfield FC/ Chester FC/ Warrington Town FC). This will be those clubs that play at a higher level in the football pyramid and have the larger fan bases. There is scope from membership from other Clubs if this is deemed appropriate.

#### Administration

The Group will be coordinated through the Uniform Operations Team at Force Headquarters.

#### Frequency

The meeting frequency will be every two to three months. The group will meet at 6pm during the week. This will not be on a Tuesday as the Clubs tend to play their fixtures then.

The meeting should be reviewed annually, and the minutes should reflect this.
