2. Finance. Including 3.50/50

John Abbott had sent us a finance report prior to the meeting. We have £14487 in our accounts. We owe the club £2997 for their share of the 50/50 sales. We are going to order another 10000 50/50 tickets before we pay the club, so that we can share the cost of printing with them. John has paid £2400 to the club for the programme pages and board costs. The Mixlr sponsorship was £1758 for the season, which is well worth the money for the superb commentary of the matches. John is going to put together a script for Matt and James so they can let fans know about the pledge.

Chelsie thanked Caroline for SST support for her cameras being serviced. Chelsie is also happy to have "Sponsored by SST on the back of her bib. Stephen Walker has agreed to audit the Annual Report.

4. Communications are reaching more people, currently 1.2k on Facebook, 1.1k on X (previously known as Twitter).
5. Bernie told us that the Website had been hacked but that he had managed to get it back up and running, the new membership is updated, Bernie is going to send John the details. All the clubs for the 2026/27 season are now on the Website. A link to Moose Tours information is also on the SST website.
6. James and Matt have done a whopping 66 commentaries this season! They thanked us for continuing to support them. They told us about the Footballers Supporters Association who may be able to help us in getting the club ready for higher leagues and other useful help. They would like to arrange a survey to find out what the fans would like from the club and SST. They would like to set up a working party to organise things like flags etc. They asked about possibly having all season ticket holders to automatically be SST members, so then we would have a bigger group and may get more engagement.
7. Steve suggested we got a memorial trophy to present at the Player of the Year evening from the coming season for the fans to choose their Player of the match throughout the season.
